POLICY UPDATES

3.20.1.1 Applications Applicants and food unit members who meet the definition of a drug felon must

agree to and pass a drug test within 30 days from either the filing date or the date that the member is notified of the drug testing requirement to be found eligible. Upon agreement to take the test, find the applicant eligible. If an applicant passes the test, he or she would be made remain eligible for ongoing benefits. If a currently eligible food unit member passes the test, he or she would continue to be eligible. If the applicant or food unit member refuses to take a drug test, he or she will be ineligible (gross deemer without a sanction) for FoodShare until he or she agrees to take a

drug test.
